HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2603

Delete lines 4 through 16 of the printed bill and insert: 1 2 "SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Transportation shall study train delays experienced 3 by trains in Oregon that are operated by the National Railroad Passenger Corporation, commonly known as Amtrak. As part of the study and to the extent possible, the department 4 $\mathbf{5}$ shall: 6 "(a) Identify delays to passenger trains waiting for an opposing passenger or freight train to arrive at a siding selected by the train dispatcher for one of the trains to clear the main 7 line; 8 9 "(b) Identify delays to passenger trains resulting from overtaking a slower freight train 10 going the same direction, including all delay time and mileage incurred following the slower 11 train until passing; 12"(c) Identify delays to passenger trains caused when an opposing freight train exceeds 13 the length of a siding, resulting in a portion of the freight train still occupying the track 14 required for the passenger train's progression; 15"(d) Identify passenger train delays arising from freight train mechanical failures; and 16 "(e) List any other reasons for passenger delays not described in paragraphs (a) to (d) 17 of this subsection. 18 "(2) The department shall present the results of the study, along with any recommended changes, in a report to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to 19 20 transportation in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 on or before September 15, 2020.". 21
