House Bill 2685

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Requires person who files to run for public office to provide campaign phone number and campaign electronic mail address. Except for de minimis personal use, requires phone number and electronic mail address to be used exclusively for purpose of supporting person's candidacy.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2019 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 249.002 to
5	249.013.
6	SECTION 2. (1) A person who files a nominating petition or declaration of candidacy for
7	public office shall provide on the nominating petition or declaration of candidacy:
8	(a) A campaign phone number; and
9	(b) A campaign electronic mail address.
10	(2) Except for de minimis personal use, the phone number and electronic mail address
11	provided under subsection (1) of this section must be used exclusively for the purpose of
12	supporting the person's candidacy for public office.
13	SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2019 Act applies to nominating petitions and declarations
14	of candidacy filed on or after the effective date of this 2019 Act.
