

House Bill 2715

Sponsored by Representative RAYFIELD (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires school districts to provide instruction on organ and tissue donation and education.
Takes effect July 1, 2020.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to transplant education in public schools.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) As an integral part of the health education curriculum for students in**
5 **the public schools of this state, each school district must provide at least 15 minutes of in-**
6 **struction per school year on organ and tissue donation and education. The instruction must**
7 **be designed to develop a knowledge of the lifesaving potential of organ and tissue donations.**

8 **(2) The Department of Education may provide technical assistance in developing the**
9 **curriculum required under this section.**

10 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2019 Act first applies to the 2020-2021 school year.**

11 **SECTION 3. This 2019 Act takes effect on July 1, 2020.**
