House Bill 2724

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Prohibits sponsor or public charter school from entering into contract or other agreement with for-profit entity to provide specified percentage of educational services for public charter school. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2019.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the provision of educational services at a public charter school by a for-profit entity;

3 and declaring an emergency.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2019 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 338.

6 SECTION 2. A sponsor or a public charter school may not enter into a contract or any

7 other agreement with a for-profit entity to provide 30 percent or more of the educational

8 services for the public charter school during a school year.

9 <u>SECTION 3.</u> Section 2 of this 2019 Act applies to contracts and agreements entered into

10 on or after the effective date of this 2019 Act.

SECTION 4. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect
July 1, 2019.
