

House Bill 2749

Sponsored by Representative MARSH

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Eliminates requirement that certificate issued to cosmetic practitioner include practitioner's address.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to certificates issued to cosmetic practitioners; amending ORS 690.048.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 690.048 is amended to read:

5 690.048. (1) The Health Licensing Office shall issue a certificate to each applicant who qualifies
6 under ORS 690.046 or 690.047. The certificate is prima facie evidence of the right of the holder to
7 practice in a field of practice for which the holder has qualified and purports to be a practitioner.

8 (2) A certificate must show the practitioner's name, [*address,*] certificate number, expiration date
9 and field of practice for which the practitioner is qualified to perform services.

10 (3) A practitioner's certificate shall indicate any specialty certification, obtained under ORS
11 690.047, for which the practitioner is qualified to provide advanced services in a field of practice.
12 Advanced services shall be defined by rules adopted by the office.
