House Bill 2827

SUMMARY

Repeals limitations on eligibility of persons who are 18 years of age or older who have physical disabilities to receive benefits from Oregon Project Independence.

5	SECTION 1. ORS 410.425 is amended to read:
6	410.425. Except as provided in ORS 410.422, the funds available for purposes of ORS 410.410 to
7	410.480 shall be kept in separate accounts in the General Fund[.] as follows:
8	(1) One account shall be used for funds appropriated for [persons otherwise] eligible persons
9	who:
10	(a) Are 60 years of age or older[.]; or
11	(b) Have physical disabilities and are 18 years of age or older; and
12	(2) [The other] One account shall be used for funds appropriated for [persons otherwise] eligible
13	persons who have Alzheimer's disease or a related disorder.
14	SECTION 2. ORS 410.430 is amended to read:
15	410.430. (1) In order to qualify for authorized services from an authorized agency or service
16	provider, each client must:
17	(a)(A) Be 60 years of age or older [or];
18	(B) Have a physical disability and be 18 years of age or older; or
19	(C) Have been diagnosed [as having] with Alzheimer's disease or a related disorder;
20	(b) Not be receiving financial assistance from the Department of Human Services, except ben-
21	efits from the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program [and] or limited Medicare reimburse-
22	ment benefits administered by the department; and
23	(c) Be assessed to be at the risk of entering an institution.
24	(2) An eligibility determination is required before any client may receive services from an au-
25	thorized agency or service provider.
