House Bill 2840

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Establishes prohibitions for registered pharmacy benefit managers.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to pharmacy benefit managers.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2019 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 735.530 to
5	735.552.
6	SECTION 2. A pharmacy benefit manager registered under ORS 735.532 may not:
7	(1) Require an insured to fill or refill prescriptions using a mail-order service.
8	(2) Prohibit a pharmacist or pharmacy from providing to a patient information regarding
9	the patient's cost share for a prescription drug and, if available, the clinical efficacy of a
10	lower cost alternative drug.
11	(3) Prohibit a pharmacist or pharmacy from selling an insured a lower cost alternative
12	drug.
13	(4) Prohibit a pharmacist or pharmacy from offering or providing delivery as an ancillary
14	service.
15	(5) Charge or collect from an insured a copayment for a drug in an amount that exceeds
16	the reimbursement the pharmacy benefit manager pays to the pharmacist or pharmacy for
17	the drug.
18	(6) Hold a pharmacist or pharmacy responsible for a fee for the adjudication of a claim
19	for reimbursement.
20	(7) Recoup from a pharmacist or pharmacy costs associated with claims for which the

pharmacist or pharmacy has already been paid, unless otherwise required by law.

(8) Penalize a pharmacist or pharmacy or retaliate against a pharmacist or pharmacy for

providing information described in subsection (2) of this section, selling a lower cost alternative drug or offering or providing delivery as described in subsection (4) of this section.

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
