

House Bill 2871

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION (at the request of Representative Margaret Doherty)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission to conduct study to determine what additional actions are necessary to meet 40-40-20 goals.

Requires commission to report findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to higher education on or before September 15, 2020.

Sunsets January 2, 2021.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to higher education; and prescribing an effective date.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Higher Education Coordinating Commission shall consult with com-**
5 **munity colleges and the public universities listed in ORS 352.002 and conduct a study to de-**
6 **termine what additional actions are necessary to meet the mission for all education beyond**
7 **high school in Oregon set forth in ORS 350.014.**

8 **(2) The commission shall present the results of the study, along with any recommended**
9 **legislative changes, in a report to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related**
10 **to higher education in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 on or before September 15,**
11 **2020.**

12 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2019 Act is repealed on January 2, 2021.**

13 **SECTION 3. This 2019 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2019**
14 **regular session of the Eightieth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.**
