

House Bill 2923

Sponsored by Representative NEARMAN

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Classifies certain persons as resident persons for purpose of purchasing licenses, tags and permits issued by State Fish and Wildlife Commission.

2 Relating to State Fish and Wildlife Commission fees.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The following persons are resident persons for purposes of purchasing li-**
5 **censes, tags and permits issued by the State Fish and Wildlife Commission:**

6 (1) **A person who pays out-of-state tuition at an Oregon institution of higher education**
7 **within 12 months prior to purchasing the license, tag or permit; or**

8 (2) **A person who presents an Oregon tax return establishing that the person satisfied a**
9 **state income tax liability within 12 months prior to purchasing the license, tag or permit.**
