## House Bill 2923

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Classifies certain persons as resident persons for purpose of purchasing licenses, tags and permits issued by State Fish and Wildlife Commission.

2	Relating to State Fish and Wildlife Commission fees.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. The following persons are resident persons for purposes of purchasing li-
5	censes, tags and permits issued by the State Fish and Wildlife Commission:
6	(1) A person who pays out-of-state tuition at an Oregon institution of higher education
7	within 12 months prior to purchasing the license, tag or permit; or
8	(2) A person who presents an Oregon tax return establishing that the person satisfied a
9	state income tax liability within 12 months prior to purchasing the license, tag or permit.
