

House Bill 2929

Sponsored by Representative HELT

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Creates offense of unlawful use of a bump-fire stock. Punishes by maximum of \$2,000 fine.
Creates offense of unlawful transfer of a bump-fire stock. Punishes by maximum of \$2,000 fine.
Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to bump-fire stocks; and prescribing an effective date.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) A person commits the offense of unlawful use of a bump-fire stock if the**
5 **person knowingly:**

6 (a) **Attaches a bump-fire stock to a firearm; or**

7 (b) **Possesses a bump-fire stock that is attached to a firearm.**

8 (2) **Unlawful use of a bump-fire stock is a Class A violation.**

9 (3) **As used in this section and section 2 of this 2019 Act:**

10 (a) **"Bump-fire stock" means a buttstock designed to be attached to a semiautomatic**
11 **firearm with the effect of increasing the rate of fire achievable by the semiautomatic firearm**
12 **to that of a fully automatic firearm by using the energy from the recoil of the firearm to**
13 **generate reciprocating action that facilitates repeated activation of the trigger.**

14 (b) **"Firearm" has the meaning given that term in ORS 166.210.**

15 **SECTION 2. (1) A person commits the offense of unlawful transfer of a bump-fire stock**
16 **if the person knowingly transfers a bump-fire stock to another person.**

17 (2) **Unlawful transfer of a bump-fire stock is a Class A violation.**

18 **SECTION 3. This 2019 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2019**
19 **regular session of the Eightieth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.**
