SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Requires State Forestry Department to report biennially to committee of Legislative Assembly regarding [environmental and employment impacts of] outcomes from all projects pursued in state under Good Neighbor Authority Agreement [projects funded in whole or in part by moneys made available to department for project purposes].

A BILL FOR AN ACT
Relating to the impacts of Good Neighbor Authority Agreement projects.
Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
SECTION 1. The State Forestry Department shall report outcomes from all projects
pursued in this state under the Good Neighbor Authority Agreement described in section 1,
chapter 96, Oregon Laws 2018. No later than December 31 of every even-numbered year, the
department shall submit the report, in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, to an interim
committee of the Legislative Assembly relating to economic development.
SECTION 2. The State Forestry Department shall produce the first report required by

section 1 of this 2019 Act no later than December 31, 2020.

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
