SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Directs Housing and Community Services Department to conduct study to estimate amount of additional homeless shelter capacity necessary in each county and cost of building or acquiring such capacity.

Directs department to submit report on findings to Legislative Assembly by January 1, 2021.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 2 Relating to homeless shelters. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. (1) The Housing and Community Services Department shall study the incidence of homelessness in each county in this state and estimate: 5 (a) The amount of additional homeless shelter capacity that would be necessary in each 6 county to shelter all homeless individuals; and 7 (b) The cost of building or acquiring such additional capacity in each county. 8 (2) The department shall submit a report on its findings to the Legislative Assembly in 9 the manner provided under ORS 192.245 no later than January 1, 2021. 10
