On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 30. 1 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 13 and insert: "SECTION 1. (1) For the purpose of assisting public bodies and private entities that serve 3 children, adolescents and families in providing trauma-informed services, the Oregon De-4 5 partment of Administrative Services shall enter into a contract with a nonprofit organization 6 that: 7 "(a) Has expertise in developing and providing trauma-informed practices and policies; "(b) Demonstrates the ability to perform statewide outreach; "(c) Has a record of working with state agencies; and 10 "(d) Is part of an academic research-based institution. 11 "(2) The contract shall provide that the nonprofit organization shall create a trauma-12 informed practice integration program in coordination and collaboration with public bodies 13 and private entities that serve children, adolescents and families, including but not limited 14 to persons who represent: 15 "(a) The Department of Human Services. 16 "(b) The Oregon Youth Authority. 17 "(c) The Department of Education. 18 "(d) The Oregon Health Authority. "(e) The Youth Development Council. 19 20 "(f) School districts. 21 "(g) Nonprofit organizations. "(h) County public health programs. 22 "(i) Juvenile crime prevention programs. 23 94 "(j) Early Learning Hubs. "(k) School health providers. 25 "(L) State and local law enforcement agencies. 26 27 "(m) The Department of Corrections. "(n) The Department of Justice. 28 "(o) The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission. 29 "(p) District attorneys. 30 31 "(q) The Judicial Department. 32 "(3) The trauma-informed practice integration program shall: "(a) Clearly define the characteristics of the target population of children, adolescents 33 34 and families to be served by the program.

"(b) Review trauma-informed practice integration programs in other states.

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"(c) Define what it means to provide trauma-informed services.

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- "(d) Develop a list of performance measures that measure the success of public bodies and private entities in providing trauma-informed services to the target population.
 - "(e) Identify trauma-informed policies and services underway across this state.
- "(f) Coordinate trauma-informed initiatives across state agencies.
 - "(g) Identify systemic barriers to and gaps in services.
- "(h) Leverage existing trauma-informed resources and initiatives to encourage consistency and eliminate duplication of resources.
 - "(i) Recommend changes to existing trauma-informed practices and policies.
- "(4) The contract entered into under this section shall provide that the nonprofit organization shall submit an annual report to the Legislative Assembly and the Governor:
 - "(a) Detailing the progress made in carrying out the provisions of this section; and
- "(b) Containing specific recommendations for any additional legislation the organization deems necessary to carry out the purposes of the trauma-informed practice integration program.
- "(5) As used in this section, 'public body' has the meaning given that term in ORS 174.109.".
- In line 15, delete "office of the Governor" and insert "Oregon Department of Administrative Services".

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
