

# House Bill 3033

Sponsored by Representatives DRAZAN, SOLLMAN, PILUSO; Representative NOBLE

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Corrections to prioritize assigning inmate with minor child to facility within reasonable distance of minor child.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to inmates with minor children.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) When assigning an inmate with a minor child to a particular correctional**  
5 **facility, either during the intake process or at any other time a transfer occurs, the De-**  
6 **partment of Corrections shall prioritize assigning the inmate to a facility within a reasonable**  
7 **distance of the minor child in order to facilitate visitation with the minor child.**

8 **(2) The department may adopt rules to carry out the provisions of this section.**
