House Bill 3033

Requires Department of Corrections to prioritize assigning inmate with minor child to facility within reasonable distance of minor child.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to inmates with minor children.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 **SECTION 1.** (1) When assigning an inmate with a minor child to a particular correctional

5 facility, either during the intake process or at any other time a transfer occurs, the De-

6 partment of Corrections shall prioritize assigning the inmate to a facility within a reasonable

7 distance of the minor child in order to facilitate visitation with the minor child.

8 (2) The department may adopt rules to carry out the provisions of this section.
