

House Bill 3103

Sponsored by Representative DOHERTY

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Transportation to study feasibility of imposing statewide assessment on transportation network companies.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to assessments on transportation network companies for the purpose of education.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Transportation shall study the feasibility of imposing**
5 **an assessment on transportation network companies that operate within this state, the**
6 **proceeds of which will go toward funding educational initiatives. The study must examine and**
7 **recommend options for imposing and collecting an assessment and ensuring adequate com-**
8 **pliance and enforcement.**

9 **(2) The department shall report the results and recommendations from the study to an**
10 **interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to transportation not later than Sep-**
11 **tember 15, 2020.**
