## House Bill 3104

Sponsored by Representative RESCHKE

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Directs Department of Education to conduct study related to spending trends of school districts and possible areas of savings for school districts.

Directs Quality Education Commission to take into consideration department study when commission prepares report for 2022.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to school district spending.
  - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
    - SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Education, in collaboration with the Quality Education Commission, shall conduct a study to evaluate spending trends for school districts and to identify potential areas of savings for school districts. The study conducted under this section must include an analysis of spending that is directly related to classroom instruction compared to spending that is used for other school district costs.
      - (2) The department shall report the results of the study conducted under this section:
    - (a) To an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to education no later than September 15, 2021; and
      - (b) On the website of the department.
  - SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2019 Act is repealed on December 31, 2020.
  - SECTION 3. For the purpose of the report prepared by the Quality Education Commission under ORS 327.506, the report that is prepared in 2022 must take into consideration the study conducted under section 1 of this 2019 Act.
  - SECTION 4. Section 3 of this 2019 Act is repealed on December 31, 2022.

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
