

# House Bill 3139

Sponsored by Representative SMITH G

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Provides definitions for certain terms relating to transportation of freight.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to transportation-related terminology.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. In order to promote efficiency in the handling and transportation of freight,**  
5 **and to promote coordination between industries, the Legislative Assembly declares that the**  
6 **following terms have the following meanings in relation to transportation of freight:**

7 (1) **"Intermodal" means pertaining to the transfer of freight between distinct modes of**  
8 **transportation.**

9 (2) **"Reload facility" means a location where freight is stored after transport by one**  
10 **transportation mode and before transport by the same or a different transportation mode.**

11 (3) **"Transload" means to transfer freight from the vehicle or container of one mode of**  
12 **transportation to that of another at an intermodal terminal.**
