2	Relating to transportation-related terminology.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. In order to promote efficiency in the handling and transportation of freight,
5	and to promote coordination between industries, the Legislative Assembly declares that the
6	following terms have the following meanings in relation to transportation of freight:
7	(1) "Intermodal" means pertaining to the transfer of freight between distinct modes of
8	transportation.
9	(2) "Reload facility" means a location where freight is stored after transport by one
10	transportation mode and before transport by the same or a different transportation mode.
11	(3) "Transload" means to transfer freight from the vehicle or container of one mode of
12	transportation to that of another at an intermodal terminal.
