House Bill 3157

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Requires Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services to amend Low-Rise Residential Dwelling Code to require alternative energy collection or generation by December 15, 2020. Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 2 Relating to residential alternative energy; and prescribing an effective date. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2019 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 455. SECTION 2. The Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services shall 5 require the Low-Rise Residential Dwelling Code to require as a standard of construction that 6 7 dwellings constructed under the code must include one or more appropriate methods of al-8 ternative energy collection or generation. SECTION 3. The Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services shall 9 take necessary steps to amend the Low-Rise Residential Dwelling Code to conform with the 10 requirements of section 2 of this 2019 Act no later than December 15, 2020. 11 12 SECTION 4. This 2019 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2019 regular session of the Eightieth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die. 13
