## House Bill 3183

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. ORS 412.029 is amended to read:
5	412.029. Each money payment of aid made to a representative payee or to a guardian or a
6	conservator under ORS 412.026 or 412.028 shall be expended by the representative payee, guardian
7	or conservator solely to make purchases to meet the needs of the individuals with respect to whom
8	the payment is made. However, the individuals may receive from the representative payee, guardian
9	or conservator such portions of the money payments, and at such intervals, as may be permitted by
10	rules adopted by the Department of Human Services.
