## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3191

On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 17 through 29 and delete page 2 and insert:

"SECTION 2. The Department of Human Services shall provide, to any child welfare caseworker whose caseload exceeds the most recent workload model reported to the Legislative Assembly by the department in its report required under ORS 409.161, the opportunity to meet with the caseworker's immediate supervisor at least once every 14 days to establish or adjust priorities in order to meet the caseworker's work obligations. In assessing the caseworker's performance, the supervisor shall take into account variables that impact the difficulty of the caseworker's assignments. The caseworker may request an oral or written response from the supervisor under this section, and the supervisor shall issue the response promptly, unless the request is inappropriate or excessive.

"SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$\_\_\_\_\_\_\_, which may be expended for the purposes of carrying out section 1 of this 2019 Act."
