On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 27 and delete pages 2 through 4 and insert
"SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, 'client,' 'confidential communication,' 'lawyer
and 'representative of the lawyer' have the meanings given those terms in ORS 40.225.
"(2) A client has a right to privately communicate with the client's lawyer and repre
sentatives of the lawyer.
"(3)(a) Any evidence derived from a confidential communication that is privileged under
ORS 40.225, between a client and the client's lawyer or a representative of the lawyer, is in
admissible in any proceeding to which the client is a party if the confidential communication
was obtained or disclosed without the consent of the client.
"(b) Paragraph (a) of this subsection does not apply to evidence offered by the client.".
