House Bill 3290

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Directs Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to study convictions. Requires report to interim committee of Legislative Assembly related to judiciary.
Sunsets January 2, 2020.
Declares emergency, effective on passage.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to convictions; and declaring an emergency.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission shall study convictions in this
5	state. The commission shall submit findings and recommendations for legislation to an in-
6	terim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary no later than December
7	31, 2019.
8	SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2019 Act is repealed on January 2, 2020.
9	SECTION 3. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
10	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect
11	on its passage.
