## House Bill 3334

Sponsored by Representative SPRENGER

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Provides that local government laws, including land use regulations, do not apply to siting of armories by Oregon Military Department.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to armories; amending ORS 396.530; and declaring an emergency.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. ORS 396.530 is amended to read:
5	396.530. (1) Notwithstanding any laws of a local government, as defined in ORS 174.116,
6	including land use regulations, as defined in ORS 197.015, armories may be constructed in lo-
7	cations not already provided with armories or in which existing armories are inadequate, where one
8	or more units of the organized militia, fully organized under this chapter and ORS chapters 398 and
9	399, may be located and where, in the judgment of the military department, it will be most conven-
10	ient to the units, and where most needed.
11	(2) All title to the armory and grounds upon which it is situated shall vest in the State of
12	Oregon.
13	SECTION 2. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
14	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect
15	on its passage.
