

House Bill 3372

Sponsored by Representative SMITH DB

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires State Department of Agriculture to adopt rules governing processing and sale of beef and lamb that does not travel in interstate commerce.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to meat.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2019 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 619.010 to**
5 **619.071.**

6 **SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section:**

7 (a) **"Interstate commerce" means the movement of commercial goods:**

8 (A) **From a processing site within Oregon to a destination outside Oregon; and**

9 (B) **Between points within Oregon, but outside Oregon while in transit.**

10 (b) **"Processing" means activities that are subject to regulation under ORS 619.010 to**
11 **619.071 or ORS chapter 603.**

12 (2) **The State Department of Agriculture shall adopt rules for the processing and sale of**
13 **beef and lamb that does not travel in interstate commerce. Notwithstanding ORS 603.015,**
14 **619.021 and 619.046, the department may adopt rules under this section that diverge from**
15 **Federal Meat Inspection Act requirements. However, the rules must include requirements**
16 **that are equivalent to the requirements of 21 U.S.C. 642, 643 and 644.**

17 (3) **The department may not administer or enforce any provision of the Federal Meat**
18 **Inspection Act with regard to beef and lamb that is subject to department rules adopted**
19 **under this section. ORS 603.034 does not apply to beef and lamb not traveling in interstate**
20 **commerce that is processed and sold as provided in department rules adopted under this**
21 **section.**
