

House Bill 3395

Sponsored by Representatives WILSON, WALLAN (at the request of Compassionate Oregon)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows person responsible for marijuana grow site who is designated to grow marijuana by more than three registry identification cardholders to transfer usable marijuana to additional registry identification cardholders.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to marijuana; and prescribing an effective date.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2019 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 475B.785 to**
5 **475B.949.**

6 **SECTION 2. A person responsible for a marijuana grow site who is designated to produce**
7 **marijuana by more than three registry identification cardholders may, pursuant to an**
8 **agreement described in ORS 475B.822, transfer to additional registry identification**
9 **cardholders usable marijuana that the person designated to produce marijuana by a registry**
10 **identification cardholder has a right to possess.**

11 **SECTION 3. (1) Section 2 of this 2019 Act becomes operative on January 1, 2020.**

12 **(2) The Oregon Health Authority may take any action before the operative date specified**
13 **in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary to enable the authority to exercise, on and**
14 **after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all of the duties, functions**
15 **and powers conferred on the authority by section 2 of this 2019 Act.**

16 **SECTION 4. This 2019 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2019**
17 **regular session of the Eightieth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.**
