"SECTION 6. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-

priated to the State Forestry Department, for the biennium ending June 30, 2019, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$3,201,253 for catastrophic wildfire insurance premium costs for the 2019 fire season.

"SECTION 7. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures established by section 2 (2), chapter 592, Oregon Laws 2017, for the biennium ending June 30, 2019, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and including federal funds from the United States Forest Service for fire protection and for research projects, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in section 2, chapter 592, Oregon Laws 2017, collected or received by the State Forestry Department, for fire protection, is increased by \$532,747 for catastrophic wildfire insurance premium costs for the 2019 fire season.

"SECTION 8. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect on its passage.".
