SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Approves certain new or increased fees adopted by Higher Education Coordinating Commission. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2019.
