SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by Department of State Lands for certain purposes.

Limits certain biennial expenditures by department from federal funds. Limits biennial expenditures by department from certain lottery funds. Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2019.
