SUMMARY

Approves certain new or increased [*fee*] **fees** adopted by Department of Transportation.
Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2019.

2 Relating to the financial administration of the Department of Transportation; and declaring an

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), an ap-**
6 **plication fee of \$600 for an ignition interlock device service center, adopted by the Depart-**
7 **ment of Transportation and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services,**
8 **is approved.**

9 **SECTION 2. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), the**
10 **following new or increased annual permit renewal fees, adopted by the Department of**
11 **Transportation and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, are ap-**
12 **proved:**

13	(1) Outdoor advertising signs		
14	50 square feet or less.....	\$	136
15	(2) Outdoor advertising signs		
16	51 to 400 square feet.....	\$	159
17	(3) Outdoor advertising signs		
18	401 to 672 square feet	\$	182
19	(4) Outdoor advertising signs

22 **SECTION 3. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), a reg-**
23 **istration plate fee of \$24.50, adopted by the Department of Transportation and approved by**
24 **the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, is approved.**

25 **SECTION 4. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
26 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect**
27 **July 1, 2019.**
