A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Department of Education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$5,504,403 for developing and implementing programs created under chapter ____, Oregon Laws 2019 (Enrolled House Bill 3427).

SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Department of Revenue, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$2,789,361, for the Corporate Division, for the implementation of the corporate activity tax established under chapter ____, Oregon Laws 2019 (Enrolled House Bill 3427).

SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Department of Revenue, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,165,000 for the core systems replacement program and the implementation of the corporate activity tax established under chapter ____, Oregon Laws 2019 (Enrolled House Bill 3427).

SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$472,740,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, as the maximum limit for payments of grant-in-aid, program costs and purchased services by the Department of Education from the Student Investment Account established by section 8, chapter ____, Oregon Laws 2019 (Enrolled House Bill 3427).

SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts

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are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, as the maximum limits for payments of grant-in-aid, program costs and purchased services by the Department of Education from the Early Learning Account established by section 51, chapter ____, Oregon Laws 2019 (Enrolled House Bill 3427), for the following purposes:

7	SECTION 9. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
8	expenditures established by section 2 (6), chapter, Oregon Laws 2019 (Enrolled Senate

10	venues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, col-
