SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Directs Department of Justice to conduct study on prosecution of domestic violence offenses and present report on findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to judiciary on or before September 15, 2020.

Sunsets January 2, 2021.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to domestic violence.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. The Department of Justice shall conduct a study on the prosecution of domestic violence offenses and present the results of the study, along with any recommended legislative changes, in a report to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 on or before September 15, 2020.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2019 Act is repealed on January 2, 2021.
