

Senate Bill 107

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Provides exemption to utility vehicles providing natural gas services from offense of illegal stopping, standing or parking.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to exemptions to offense of illegal stopping, standing or parking; creating new provisions;
3 and amending ORS 811.560.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 811.560 is amended to read:

6 811.560. This section provides exemptions from ORS 811.550 and 811.555. The following ex-
7 emptions are applicable as provided under ORS 811.550:

8 (1) When applicable, this subsection exempts school buses or worker transport buses stopped on
9 a roadway to load or unload workers or children, providing that the flashing school bus safety lights
10 on the bus are operating.

11 (2) When applicable, this subsection exempts vehicles stopped, standing or parked momentarily
12 to pick up or discharge a passenger.

13 (3) When applicable, this subsection exempts vehicles stopped, standing or parked momentarily
14 for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading property or passengers.

15 (4) When applicable, this subsection exempts vehicles owned or operated by the state, a county
16 or city when stopping, standing or parking is necessary to perform maintenance or repair work on
17 the roadway.

18 (5) When applicable, this subsection exempts vehicles from the prohibitions and penalties when
19 the driver's disregard of the prohibitions is necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic.

20 (6) When applicable, this subsection exempts vehicles acting in compliance with law or at the
21 direction of a police officer or a traffic control device.

22 (7) When applicable, this subsection exempts the driver of a vehicle that is disabled in such
23 manner and to such extent that the driver cannot avoid stopping or temporarily leaving the disabled
24 vehicle in a prohibited position.

25 (8) When applicable, this subsection exempts vehicles owned or operated by the State Depart-
26 ment of Fish and Wildlife when stopping, standing or parking is necessary to enable employees to
27 release fish.

28 (9) When applicable, this subsection exempts vehicles momentarily stopped to allow oncoming
29 traffic to pass before making a right-hand or left-hand turn or momentarily stopped in preparation
30 for or while negotiating an exit from the road.

NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.

1 (10) When applicable, this subsection exempts commercial vehicles that are stopped, standing
2 or parked when stopping, standing or parking is necessary to engage in any activity associated with
3 the collection of solid waste, recyclable material or yard debris, as those terms are defined in ORS
4 459.005.

5 **(11) When applicable, this subsection exempts vehicles owned or operated by a utility**
6 **when stopping, standing or parking to install, repair, maintain, operate or upgrade natural**
7 **gas service.**

8 **SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 811.560 by section 1 of this 2019 Act apply to con-**
9 **duct occurring on or after the effective date of this 2019 Act.**

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
