

Senate Bill 121

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Workforce)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Bureau of Labor and Industries to conduct study and make recommendations regarding implementing paid family and medical leave program and to report results, including recommendations, to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to business and labor on or before February 1, 2021.

2 Relating to employee leave.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Bureau of Labor and Industries shall conduct a study and make**
5 **recommendations on options for implementing a paid family and medical leave program in**
6 **this state.**

7 **(2) The bureau shall submit a report of the results of the study, including recommen-**
8 **dations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to**
9 **business and labor in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 on or before February 1, 2021.**
