

Senate Bill 122

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Workforce)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Bureau of Labor and Industries to conduct study of issues related to predictability in employee work schedules in Oregon and to report results to interim committee of Legislative Assembly related to business and labor on or before February 1, 2021.

2 Relating to employee work schedules.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Bureau of Labor and Industries shall conduct a study of issues related**
5 **to predictability in employee work schedules in Oregon and present the results of the study**
6 **in a report to an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to business and labor**
7 **in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 on or before February 1, 2021.**
