

Senate Bill 183

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Human Services)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Early Learning Council to study and make recommendations on provisions of state law relating to regulation of child care providers. Requires council to submit report on findings to Legislative Assembly by January 1, 2021.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to the regulation of child care providers.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) The Early Learning Council shall study and make recommendations on provisions of state law relating to the regulation of child care providers.

(2) The council shall submit a report on its findings to an appropriate committee of the Legislative Assembly no later than January 1, 2021.
