| 11 | "(2) The Department of Education shall develop recommendations to schools in this state |
| 12 | for practices and alternative technologies that would reduce students' exposure to micro- |
| 13 | wave radiation that the review described in subsection (1) of this section identifies as |
| 14 | harmful. |
| 15 | "SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro- |
| 16 | priated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the |
| 17 | General Fund, the amount of \$10,000 for the purpose of carrying out the authority's func- |
| 18 | tions and duties under section 1 of this 2019 Act. |
| 19 | "SECTION 3. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public |
| 20 | peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect |
| 21 | on its passage.". |
