

**HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO  
A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 29  
(INCLUDING AMENDMENTS TO RESOLVE CONFLICTS)**

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 2, after “109.610,” delete the rest of the line and  
2 delete lines 3 through 12 and insert “413.101, 418.325, 431A.055, 431A.070, 431A.183, 432.510, 432.520,  
3 433.004, 433.045, 433.055, 433.075, 433.269, 433.847, 435.010, 442.315, 443.035, 448.011, 448.020, 448.030,  
4 448.051, 448.060, 448.100, 475B.895, 676.150, 676.560, 676.565, 676.579, 676.590, 676.595, 676.608,  
5 676.612, 676.613, 676.622, 676.669, 676.689, 677.370, 681.730, 681.743, 681.746, 681.749, 681.758, 682.025,  
6 682.035, 682.039, 682.208, 688.815 and 700.035; repealing ORS 181A.330 and 181A.335 and section 2,  
7 chapter \_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2019 (Enrolled Senate Bill 142); and declaring an emergency.”.

8 On page 2, after line 14, insert:

9 **“SECTION 1a. If Senate Bill 142 becomes law, section 2, chapter \_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2019**  
10 **(Enrolled Senate Bill 142) (amending ORS 109.610), is repealed and ORS 109.610, as amended**  
11 **by section 1 of this 2019 Act, is amended to read:**

12 “109.610. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a minor who may have come into  
13 contact with any sexually transmitted infection[, *including HIV,*] may give consent to the furnishing  
14 of hospital, medical or surgical care related to the diagnosis or treatment of the sexually transmitted  
15 infection, if the sexually transmitted infection is one that is required by law or regulation adopted  
16 pursuant to law to be reported to a state or local health agency or officer. Consent given under this  
17 subsection may not be disaffirmed based on minority.

18 “(2)(a) The consent of a parent or legal guardian of a minor described in subsection (1) of this  
19 section is not required to authorize the care described in subsection (1) of this section.

20 “(b) A parent or legal guardian who does not consent to the care described in subsection (1) of  
21 this section is not liable for payment for the care provided under subsection (1) of this section.

22 **“SECTION 1b. The amendments to ORS 109.610 by section 1a of this 2019 Act become**  
23 **operative on the effective date of chapter \_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2019 (Enrolled Senate Bill**  
24 **142).”.**

25 On page 37, delete lines 4 through 45 and delete pages 38 through 83.

26 On page 84, delete lines 1 through 19 and insert:

27 **“NOTE:** Sections 57 through 110 were deleted by amendment. Subsequent sections were not  
28 renumbered.”.

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
