

Senate Bill 302

Sponsored by Senator HANSELL (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows person taking certain nuisance game mammals to retain game meat if meat is offered to charitable organizations and refused.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the use of game meat.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "charitable organization" and "game meat" have**
5 **the meanings given those terms in ORS 619.095.**

6 **(2) A person who takes an antelope, bighorn sheep, deer, elk, moose or mountain goat**
7 **under a permit described in ORS 498.012 shall offer the game meat to a charitable organiza-**
8 **tion. If the person offers the game meat to at least _____ charitable organizations, and the**
9 **game meat is refused, the person may retain the meat for private, noncommercial use. If the**
10 **person chooses not to retain the game meat for private, noncommercial use, the person may**
11 **make any disposition authorized by the State Fish and Wildlife Commission by rule.**
