

Senate Bill 338

Sponsored by Senator BAERTSCHIGER JR (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Provides that members of Oregon Army National Guard and Oregon Air National Guard may receive training in wildland firefighting from public or private entities.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to the Oregon National Guard; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Pursuant to rules adopted by the Oregon Military Department, members of**
5 **the Oregon Army National Guard and the Oregon Air National Guard may receive training**
6 **in wildland firefighting skills from public or private entities.**

7 **SECTION 2. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
8 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect**
9 **on its passage.**
