Senate Bill 338

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Provides that members of Oregon Army National Guard and Oregon Air National Guard may receive training in wildland firefighting from public or private entities.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to the Oregon National Guard; and declaring an emergency. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. Pursuant to rules adopted by the Oregon Military Department, members of the Oregon Army National Guard and the Oregon Air National Guard may receive training 5 in wildland firefighting skills from public or private entities. 6 7 SECTION 2. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect 8 on its passage. 9 10
