

Senate Bill 345

Sponsored by Senator BAERTSCHIGER JR (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys for distribution to State Workforce and Talent Development Board and local workforce development boards for expenditure, in accordance with federal workforce legislation, in support of job training opportunities.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to an appropriation in support of job training opportunities; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, for**
5 **the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$25,000,000 for**
6 **distribution to the State Workforce and Talent Development Board and local workforce de-**
7 **velopment boards for expenditure, in accordance with ORS 660.300 to 660.364, in support of**
8 **job training opportunities.**

9 **SECTION 2. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
10 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect**
11 **on its passage.**
