

Senate Bill 424

Sponsored by Senator FREDERICK (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires law enforcement agency to establish mental health wellness policy for addressing issues related to mental health wellness of law enforcement officers employed by agency.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to mental health wellness policies.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "law enforcement agency" means:**

5 (a) **A city or municipal police department.**

6 (b) **A county sheriff's office.**

7 (c) **The Oregon State Police.**

8 (d) **A police department established by a university under ORS 352.121 or 353.125.**

9 (2) **A law enforcement agency shall establish a mental health wellness policy for ad-**
10 **dresssing issues related to the mental health wellness of law enforcement officers employed**
11 **by the agency.**
