Requires law enforcement agency to establish mental health wellness policy for addressing issues related to mental health wellness of law enforcement officers employed by agency.

(1) As used in this section, "law enforcement agency" means: 4 (a) A city or municipal police department. 5 (b) A county sheriff's office. 7 (c) The Oregon State Police. 8 (d) A police department established by a university under ORS 352.121 or 353.125. 9 (2) A law enforcement agency shall establish a mental health wellness policy for addressing issues related to the mental health wellness of law enforcement officers employed 10 by the agency. 11
