

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 455

- 1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 30 and delete page 2 and insert:
- 2 **“SECTION 1.** ORS 352.629 is amended to read:
- 3 **“352.629.** (1) As used in this section:
- 4 **“(a)** ‘Apprentice’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 660.010.
- 5 **“[(b)** ‘Apprenticeable occupation’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 660.010.]
- 6 **“[(c)** ‘Apprenticeship training program’ means the total system of apprenticeship that a particular
- 7 local joint committee, as defined in ORS 660.010, operates, including the local joint committee’s regis-
- 8 tered standards and all other terms and conditions for qualifying, recruiting, selecting, employing and
- 9 training apprentices in an apprenticeable occupation.]
- 10 **“(b)** ‘Community college’ means a community college as defined in ORS 341.005 or a
- 11 community college district as defined in ORS 341.005.
- 12 **“(c)** ‘Institution of higher education’ means a public university listed in ORS 352.002, a
- 13 community college or the Oregon Health and Science University.
- 14 **“(d)** ‘Minority individual’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 200.005.
- 15 **“(e)** ‘Qualified contracts’:
- 16 **“(A)** Means contracts that:
- 17 **“[(A)] (i)** Are for improvements to real property [*in connection with the University of Oregon*
- 18 *Campus for Accelerating Scientific Impact*];
- 19 **“[(B)] (ii)** Have a cost that, at the time the contract is executed, is estimated to be greater than
- 20 *[\$200,000;] \$8 million*; and
- 21 **“[(C)] (iii)** Are to be paid, **in whole or in part**, from proceeds of bonds issued [*under Article*
- 22 *XI-G of the Oregon Constitution*] **by the State of Oregon.**
- 23 **“(B)** Does not include contracts for purchase or installation of specialty medical or re-
- 24 search equipment or any necessary related personal property or fixtures sold or installed by
- 25 a vendor of such equipment.
- 26 **“(f)** ‘Woman’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 200.005.
- 27 **“(2)** An institution of higher education may not award a qualified contract to a prospec-
- 28 tive contractor unless the prospective contractor is a training agent as defined in ORS
- 29 **660.010.**
- 30 **“[(2)] (3)** [*The University of Oregon*] **Except as provided in subsection (5) of this section, an**
- 31 **institution of higher education**, in all qualified contracts, shall require contractors to:
- 32 **“[(a)** *Employ apprentices to perform 15 percent of the work hours that workers in apprenticeable*
- 33 *occupations perform under the contract, in a manner consistent with the apprentices’ respective ap-*
- 34 *prenticeship training programs;*]
- 35 **“(a)** Award each subcontract with an estimated cost of at least \$200,000 only to a sub-

1 **contractor who is a training agent as defined in ORS 660.010;**

2 “(b) Establish and execute a plan for outreach, recruitment and retention of women and minority  
3 individuals to perform work under the contract; and

4 “(c) Require any subcontractors engaged by the contractors to abide by the requirements set  
5 forth in [paragraphs (a) and (b)] **paragraph (b)** of this subsection.

6 “[3] (4) On or before February 1 of each year, [*the University of Oregon*] **institutions of higher**  
7 **education with ongoing qualified contracts** shall report to the Joint Committee on Ways and  
8 Means or Joint Interim Committee on Ways and Means on the amount of work performed by ap-  
9 prentices, women and minority individuals under qualified contracts.

10 “(5) **The requirements of subsection (3) of this section do not apply to a qualified contract**  
11 **if the institution of higher education determines that compliance with the requirements**  
12 **would, with respect to the qualified contract:**

13 “(a) **Cause unreasonable expense or delay; or**

14 “(b) **Limit the pool of bidders to fewer than three.**

15 “**SECTION 2. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, the amendments to**  
16 **ORS 352.629 by section 1 of this 2019 Act apply to contracts first advertised or otherwise**  
17 **solicited on or after January 1, 2021, or, for contracts not advertised or solicited, to con-**  
18 **tracts first entered into on or after January 1, 2021.**

19 “(2) **For Portland State University, Oregon State University, the University of Oregon**  
20 **and the Oregon Health and Science University, the amendments to ORS 352.629 by section 1**  
21 **of this 2019 Act apply to contracts first advertised or otherwise solicited on or after January**  
22 **1, 2020, or, for contracts not advertised or solicited, to contracts first entered into on or**  
23 **after January 1, 2020.”.**
