

Senate Bill 465

Sponsored by Senator BOQUIST (at the request of Mary Ellerbrook) (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to conduct study on sentences imposed on first-time sex offenders and present report on findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to judiciary on or before September 15, 2020.

Sunset January 2, 2021.

2 Relating to first-time sex offenders.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission shall conduct a study on sentences**
5 **imposed on first-time sex offenders and present the results of the study, along with any re-**
6 **commended legislative changes, in a report to the interim committees of the Legislative**
7 **Assembly related to the judiciary in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 on or before**
8 **September 15, 2020.**

9 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2019 Act is repealed on January 2, 2021.**
