

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 47

By COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES

March 29

1 On page 3 of the printed bill, after line 6, insert:

2 “(g) A person who is a member of a federally recognized Indian tribe in this state and who is  
3 engaged in tribal fishing or a tribal ceremony.”.

4 On page 4, after line 6, insert:

5 **“SECTION 8. The State Marine Board shall collaborate with relevant recreation user  
6 groups and organizations and law enforcement agencies that enforce boating regulations for  
7 the purpose of educating nonmotorized boat users about the requirement to obtain a  
8 waterway access permit under section 5 of this 2019 Act.**

9 **“SECTION 9. Section 8 of this 2019 Act is repealed on January 2, 2022.”.**

10 In line 7, delete “8” and insert “10”.

11 On page 5, line 31, delete “9” and insert “11”.

12 On page 6, line 10, delete “10” and insert “12”.

13 In line 18, delete “11” and insert “13”.

14 In line 28, delete “12” and insert “14”.

15 In line 40, delete “13” and insert “15” and delete “8” and insert “10”.

16 Delete lines 42 through 45.

17 On page 7, delete lines 1 through 4 and insert:

18 **“SECTION 16. (1) The State Marine Board shall submit two reports to the interim com-  
19 mittees of the Legislative Assembly related to natural resources, in the manner provided in  
20 ORS 192.245, on the implementation of sections 2 to 7 of this 2019 Act and the amendments  
21 to ORS 830.110, 830.565, 830.570, 830.575 and 830.990 by sections 10 to 14 of this 2019 Act. Each  
22 report must include the following:**

23 **“(a) An overview of the rules adopted by the board;**

24 **“(b) A description of the board’s educational outreach efforts;**

25 **“(c) Information about the number of waterway access permits issued;**

26 **“(d) Information about the number of citations and warnings issued for violation of sec-  
27 tion 5 of this 2019 Act; and**

28 **“(e) A description of the revenue and expenses related to the issuance of waterway ac-  
29 cess permits.**

30 **“(2) The first report must be submitted no later than September 15, 2020.**

31 **“(3) The second report must be submitted no later than September 15, 2021.**

32 **“SECTION 17. Section 16 of this 2019 Act is repealed on January 2, 2022.**

33 **“SECTION 18. (1) Sections 2 to 9 of this 2019 Act and the amendments to ORS 830.110,  
34 830.565, 830.570 and 830.575 by sections 10 and 12 to 14 of this 2019 Act become operative on  
35 January 1, 2020.**

1       **“(2) The amendments to ORS 830.990 by section 11 of this 2019 Act become operative on**  
2 **August 1, 2020.**

3       **“(3) The State Marine Board may take any action before the operative date specified in**  
4 **subsection (1) of this section that is necessary to enable the board to exercise, on and after**  
5 **the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all the duties, functions and**  
6 **powers conferred on the board by sections 2 to 9 of this 2019 Act and the amendments to**  
7 **ORS 830.110, 830.565, 830.570 and 830.575 by sections 10 and 12 to 14 of this 2019 Act.”.**

8       In line 5, delete “15” and insert “19”.

9       In line 8, delete “16” and insert “20”.

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
