

Senate Bill 510

Sponsored by Senator BENTZ (at the request of Glen Morinaga) (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Human Services to promulgate rules regarding certain employment and hiring practices.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the Department of Human Services.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. In addition to any requirements in the State Personnel Relations Law, the**
5 **Department of Human Services shall, by rule:**

6 (1) **Require psychological evaluations for all department employees in management ser-**
7 **vice, as defined in ORS 240.212;**

8 (2) **Prohibit any department practice of eliminating positions to rehire employees at lower**
9 **seniority classifications;**

10 (3) **Minimize department travel expenditures for training, including by utilizing telecon-**
11 **ferencing or requiring training attendees to carpool;**

12 (4) **Require all qualified applicants for department positions to meet certain minimum**
13 **qualifications; and**

14 (5) **Minimize the ability of applicants for department positions to substitute experience**
15 **for education.**

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NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
